

SUGGESTED ABC HOMESCHOOL SCHEDULE

Although Answers Bible Curriculum was designed to be a Sunday school/Bible curriculum for churches, it can easily be adapted for homeschool and other uses. One way to use ABC as a homeschool Bible curriculum is outlined below.



Weekly Schedule

- Each ABC lesson will take three class sessions, 30 to 40 minutes each. The Unit review lesson will take two class sessions.
- If you teach Bible five days a week, the total time to complete each Unit of lessons is about six weeks. You should be able to complete all 200 ABC lessons in three years.

DAY 1

- Review previous lessons using the Flip Chart or the Lesson Theme Posters.
- Teach the first section or two of Studying God's Word (about 1/2 of the lesson).
- Choose one or more optional activities to do.

DAY 2

- Cover the remaining teaching in the Teacher Guide to the end of the Lesson.
- Read the Applying God's Word section while your student colors the coloring sheet.
- Watch any video clips that correspond with the lesson.
- Choose one or more activities to do.

DAY 3

- Have your child complete the front side of the Student Take Home Sheet.
- Read the OutWord section on the back page together with your child.
- Read the Justin & Jessie story aloud (PreK-3rd)
- Give your child a quiz using the Review Questions.

EVERY DAY

- Practice the Memory Verse with your child using the Memory Verse poster and/or the Memory Verse songs (audio or video).
- Practice learning the order of the books of the Bible using the Books of the Bible poster or the Books of the Bible Flashcards.
- Practice learning the attributes of God using the Attributes of God poster.
- Pray with your child.
