The second statement is false. Time began at creation, which was only about 6,000 years ago.

3. According to Colossians 1:16–17, Jesus is "before all things," which means God made him first.

According to Colossians 1:16–17, "All things were created through him" is referring to Jesus being our Creator.

The first statement is false. Jesus is before all things because he is eternal. He was with God the Father in the beginning because he is God the Son. Jesus had no beginning.

The Son of God is called Jesus in the Old Testament.

The second statement is false. The Son of God is not called Jesus until he came to earth as recorded in the New Testament.
