

Gift Certificate

Materials

- Gift Certificates (next page)
- Crayons, markers, or colored pencils
- Christmas ribbon in 10-inch lengths
- Optional: glue and glitter or jewel stickers

Instructions

Print one Gift Certificate for each student and have them fill in the blanks with their own ideas of something they can do for someone in their family. For example, they could bake cookies for Dad, clean up the dishes for Mom, help a brother clean his room, read a story to a younger sibling, etc.

Have students color and decorate their certificates. If using glue, allow to dry before rolling the certificate and tying with ribbon.

Suggested Discussion
