- 1. Who did the prophet Malachi say would come to prepare the way for the Savior? A messenger.
- 2. What was the name of the old man who was burning incense in the temple when the angel Gabriel appeared to him? *Zechariah*.
- 3. Who did Gabriel say Zechariah's son would be? The messenger.
- 4. What was Zechariah's job? He was a priest.
- 5. Who was Zechariah's wife? Elizabeth.
- 6. What were Zechariah and Elizabeth told to name their son? John.
- 7. What happened to Zechariah because he didn't believe the angel? He was made mute, unable to speak, until his baby was born and named John.
- 8. What was Joseph planning to do when he found out Mary was expecting a baby before they were married? *Divorce her quietly.*
- 9. Who did God send in a dream to give a message to Joseph? An angel.
- 10. What was Joseph told to do in his dream? Take Mary as his wife.
- **11. What did the angel tell Joseph about the baby Mary was expecting?** *The baby was from the Holy Spirit; he would save the people from their sins; he was the Savior.*
- 12. What did the angel tell Joseph to name the baby? Jesus.
