#### I. Look at the Problem You've Got without God!

**Psalm 53:1-3** "The fool has said in his heart, 'There is no God.' They are corrupt, and have done abominable iniquity; there is none who does good. ### A. Many People Don't Want God Anymore – But They Still Want the Safety Net of a Free-Floating Morality and Justice

**Five of the 'New Ten Commandments'** according to Richard Dawkins in *God Delusion* 

- 1. Do not do to others what you would not want them to do to you.
- 2. In all things, strive to cause no harm.

- 3. Treat your fellow human beings, your fellow living things, and the world in general with love, honesty, faithfulness and respect.
- 4. Do not overlook evil or shrink from administering justice, but always be ready to forgive wrongdoing freely admitted and honestly regretted.
- 5. Live life with a sense of joy and wonder. (*God Delusion*, Richard Dawkins, p. 263)
- Apart from God why should anyone think of someone other than themselves?'
- And what's going to sustain any sense of joy and wonder in my life?

Only God can provide the security net and the foundation of justice that human heart longs for.

**Psalm 89:14** "Righteousness and justice are the foundation of Your throne; mercy and truth go before Your face."

**Psalm 33:4-5** "For the word of the Lord is right, and all His work is done in truth. He loves righteousness and justice; the earth is full of the goodness of the Lord."

"Every normal person recognizes that we must have moral rules that transcend mere men - that is, rules that come from above, and are truly authoritative - in order for true freedom to exist. He who ignores these rules denies in principle the safeguard of human prosperity, and invites tyranny. The village atheist cannot see this, because he is blinded by his hatred of God. He thinks the existence of a sovereign God limits his freedom, when in reality it is God who establishes it. If human rights are given to us by man, they can just as easily be taken away by man. You may praise the Golden Rule, but when you take God out from behind it, all morality loses its power. The atheist has no Golden Rule because he has no Golden Ruler. The atheist has, in fact, a gold-plated rule. It has the appearance of morality (stolen from religion) but a cold iron core. #### B. Without God You Don't Just Struggle to Make Right Choices – You Struggle to Make Sense Out of Life
