


DURING CREATION AND THE FLOOD, unique geologic processes deposited most of the earth's rock layers. On Day 3 of creation, dry land appeared above the seas (Genesis 1:9). Later, the one-time, year-long Flood deposited most of the earth's fossil-bearing layers.

PAST, RAPID PROCESSES formed Grand Canyon's layers



The earth's rock layers represent the results of this slow accumulation over time.

FOR BILLIONS OF YEARS, the same basic geologic

processes have been building new rock layers.
