# God created you!

**We** were created in God's image—we don't share an ancestor with the animals! We need to know more about our Creator so that we can become more like Him. We can learn about Him by studying His Word—the Bible.

You can begin learning more about your Creator and Savior by reading a few verses each day from the Bible. A good place to start is a book called John. Your parents or teachers will be glad to help you read and study the Bible.

# God wants you to obey Him!

**God** is holy. That means He is without sin. He wants us to be holy like He is. We can show our love for God by obeying His commands. We can learn what He wants us to do by reading the Bible.

Here are some of His commands:

- Love one another (John 15:12).
- Obey your father and mother (Ephesians 6:1–3).
- Be kind (Ephesians 4:32).
- Tell the truth (Ephesians 4:25).

# God wants you to talk to Him!

**While** Jesus was on earth, He talked with His disciples. He also talked to His heavenly Father through prayer. We can follow His example by talking to God.

We can pray anytime, anywhere, and about anything. We can tell God that we love Him and that we're thankful for everything He does for us. We can ask Him for things. For example, we can ask Him to save our friends from hell, or to heal our sister.

*Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God.*

*Philippians 4:6*





# God forgives you!

**Even** though we have become children of God, we will still sin (disobey God). But we should want to stop sinning (for example, stop lying, cheating, envying, being unkind, being quick to anger). Instead, we should want to do what pleases God (telling the truth, loving others more than we love ourselves, serving others).

When we sin, we should pray and confess our sin to God. We can tell Him we are sorry, and He will forgive us. We can ask God to help us to honor Him in all that we do and say.

*If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.*

*1 John 1:9*



# God wants you to share the good news!

**No** matter what we look like or where we live, all people are part of Adam and Eve's family. We are all sinners. Everyone needs to hear how they can become part of God's family through Jesus Christ. This is good news, and we should share it!

We can start by sharing the good news of salvation with our family, friends, and neighbors! Do you know someone you can tell about Jesus?

*Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations. Matthew 28:19*



# God wants you to spend time with others in His family!

**Since** you're part of the family of God, you're not alone! You have many brothers and sisters all around the world. All of those who repent and believe that Jesus was punished for them on the cross are part of God's family.

We please God when we spend time with others in His family. God wants us to attend a church that teaches God's Word completely and truthfully. He also wants us to look for ways to do kind things for other people.

*And let us consider one another in order to stir up love and good works, not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as is the manner of some, but exhorting one another.*
