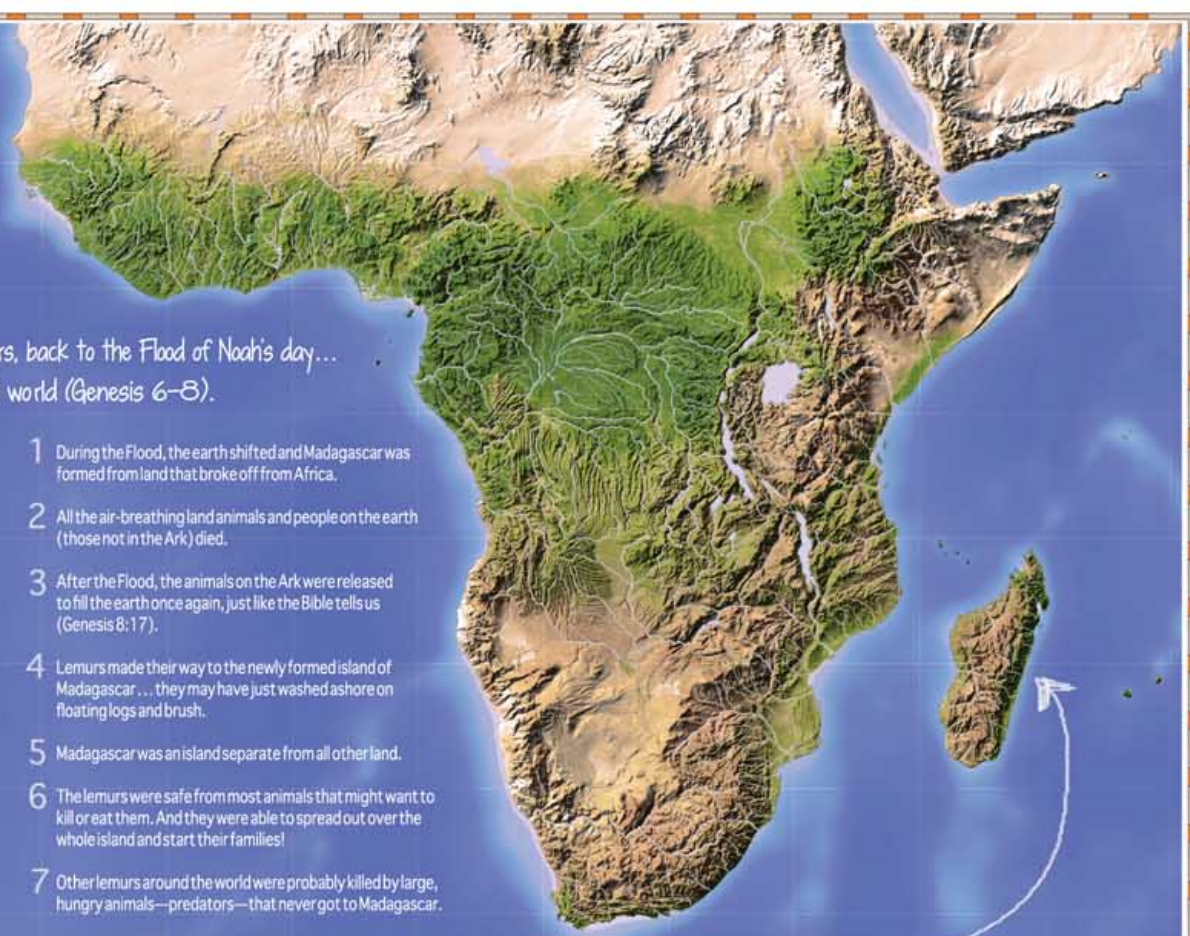


Lemurs

found on Madagascar!



Let's go back some 4,500 years, back to the Flood of Noah's day...
God's judgment on a wicked world (Genesis 6-8).

- 1 During the Flood, the earth shifted and Madagascar was formed from land that broke off from Africa.
- 2 All the air-breathing land animals and people on the earth (those not in the Ark) died.
- 3 After the Flood, the animals on the Ark were released to fill the earth once again, just like the Bible tells us (Genesis 8:17).
- 4 Lemurs made their way to the newly formed island of Madagascar... they may have just washed ashore on floating logs and brush.
- 5 Madagascar was an island separate from all other land.
- 6 The lemurs were safe from most animals that might want to kill or eat them. And they were able to spread out over the whole island and start their families!
- 7 Other lemurs around the world were probably killed by large, hungry animals—predators—that never got to Madagascar.

And that could be why lemurs live on Madagascar today!
