# Aliens at the Creation Museum? New Creationist Planetarium Show Takes Launch

**PETERSBURG, Kentucky, Sept. 8, 2015** — Creation Museum astronomer Dr. Danny Faulkner has just put the finishing touches on his new planetarium show “Aliens: Fact or Fiction?” It premiered this week at the renowned museum near Cincinnati.

Inside the state-of-the-art Stargazer’s Planetarium, guests can now travel the universe looking for answers to questions such as:

- Are we alone in the universe?
- Does life exist on other planets?
- Have people really seen UFOs?
- Are there answers in the Bible to these questions about intelligent life in outer space?

The museum's talented animators collaborated with Dr. Faulkner to produce “Aliens: Fact or Fiction?” and the new program is being shown on a Digistar 5 digital projection system. It provides guests with a rich, full-color, high-resolution experience.

Dr. Faulkner stated: “Aliens play a big role in our culture today. We see them often in TV shows and Hollywood movies. While at our museum, visitors have been asking us about the possibility of UFOs and life in outer space. Our fun new program shows various movie clips from the popular culture and shares biblical insights.”

Since 2007, over one million guests have enjoyed the Stargazer’s Planetarium and have been blessed by the Bible-upholding messages of its various shows, especially the favorite, “The Created Cosmos.”

Ken Ham, founder and CEO of the popular museum, playfully stated: “Our museum visitors can now meet an alien! Well, the alien is a fictional cartoon character, but we use this made-up alien in our new show to help explain astronomy topics for young and old from a biblical perspective.”

Ham added: “It’s one thing to watch a video on big-screen TV, but if you have not experienced a professionally designed planetarium with its domed ceiling, you’re missing out on a special way to explore the cosmos and learn more about God’s

handiwork!”

Running 19 minutes, “Aliens: Fact or Fiction?” is a separate admission and tickets cost \$7.95.

Answers in Genesis is an apologetics (i.e., Bible-defending) ministry based in northern Kentucky, near Cincinnati. The organization publishes an award-winning magazine called “Answers,” hosts one of the most popular religious websites in the world (up to 2.2 million visitors a month), and produces a daily radio broadcast (880 stations) and weekly TV program. The museum, located west of the Cincinnati Airport, has welcomed 2.5 million visitors, and its sister attraction, a full-size Ark at the theme park called Ark Encounter, opens in Williamstown, Kentucky late summer 2016.
