WHAT: The [Creation Museum](#) will offer free admission to the public during the day, Christmas Eve. Answers in Genesis, which operates the museum, wants this gift to the community to be a reminder of the greatest Christmas gift of all – the free gift of salvation through Jesus Christ, the Babe in the manger.

OTHER DETAILS: In addition, the museum will continue its special free evening program, "Christmas Town," December 26 and 28 from 5 p.m. to 8 p.m., which includes a live nativity, three ziplines over the beautifully lit gardens, and dazzling lights. Last Saturday, over 6,800 visitors attended. Annually, crowds of up to 25,000 guests visit over the eight nights of the event, with attendance this year the highest yet. In addition, museum admission is only \$5 after 5 p.m. during Christmas Town.
