

Instructions:


- 1. Print this page in color on paper or cardstock.
- 2. Cut the bookmark out along the outside dotted lines and fold it in half along the center line.
- 3. Glue the two sides together so it stays folded.
- 4. Put a piece of cardboard in the center of the paper before gluing it for a sturdier bookmark.
- 5. Cover with clear contact paper or have it laminated at an office supply store so it lasts longer.
- 6. Poke a hole in the top of the bookmark and tie a ribbon, string, etc. through as a tassel.

Steps 4, 5, and 6 are optional.

Trim on dashed lines, and fold on solid line in center.
