Fun Food To Fix:

Walnut Sandwiches

To celebrate the land flowing with milk and honey, concoct this tasty "sandwich."

You will need: 2 walnut halves for each sandwich; 3 oz. cream cheese; 3 tablespoons honey

Mix the honey and cream cheese together until it is well blended and smooth. Put one teaspoon of the cream cheese/honey mixture on a walnut half. Cover with another half and press together lightly. Arrange the "sandwiches" on a plate, then call your family for a treat!

Create-A-Craft:

Be royalty for a day—make a crown!

For each student you will need: 12" x 18" construction paper; glue or paste; beads, fake jewels, or markers to decorate the crown

Cut a piece of construction paper about six inches wide and long enough to make a tube to fit around the student's head. You may want to make and cut out a design on the top edge of

the crown. Glue beads or fake jewels onto the crown, or use crayons and markers to decorate the crown. When it is finished, glue or paste the ends together. When it is dry, try it on. Each child can be a different king.

When you wear the crown, be sure to tell your family and friends about King David and how he trusted the Lord!
