Cut 15 cards measuring 2 x 4 inches from paper or poster board. On each card print the name of a different dinosaur. (Be sure the names are spelled correctly) Place the pile of cards upside down in the center square. Each player takes a turn choosing a card. Whatever number you end on as you spell out the word is your score for that turn. When you finish your turn, place the card upside down on the bottom of the pile. Start with the next square when your turn comes again. After 10 turns around add the scores. The highest score wins. NOTE: You can add more cards with creation words. You can use colored buttons or cardboard circles for your markers. You can also make a larger game board out of poster board and color it. Ask your parents to play with you.
