## **FOSSILS**

Fossils are clues to the past. Fossils are remains of plants, marine creatures and land animals that lived six or seven thousand years ago. Each fossils has a special story to tell us about God's awesome creation.

The word "fossil" comes from a Latin word that means "to be dug up." More than 250,000 different kinds of fossils have been found.

Fossils also tell us about God's mighty works. Billions of fossils have been found in every continent of the world. Most of them were made at the time of the great Flood. Plants and animals were buried suddenly under mud, sand and lava.

Fossils are generally not being formed today. When animals die scavengers usually pick the meat from their bones. After a time the bones disintegrate.

Fossils give us valuable scientific clues, and they also give us a warning from God. For more information about fossils read pages 19-22 in TMD.
