

## Cypher Wheel

Photocopy this page, and then cut out the two circles. Punch a hole through the center in the middle of the circle, then insert a brad to hold the two together, the smaller one in front. If A=D, then place the smaller circle so that the D lines up under the bigger circle's A, then decode the letters one by one!

- If you set your Cypher Wheel so that A=G, then "Africa" would look like this: Glxoig

- If you set your Cypher Wheel so that A=P, then "barons" would look like this: qpgdch
- How would "truce" look if A=Y?
- Or if A=D?
- If P=M, which vocabulary word would look like this: phufkdqw?

Try writing some more vocabulary words in your own Cypher Wheel Code! See if your parents or brothers and sisters can decode them.
