Acting-Up History:

Cast: Narrator, Florence Nightingale, Miss Social Opinion, Doctor Disapproval, Wounded Soldiers Chorus—each with appropriate bandages

Narrator:

Florence:

Narrator:

Soldiers Chorus: (All together, with enthusiasm and much waving of casts and bandages)

Doctor Disapproval: (moving to Center Stage)
Ahem!
Wait! Stop! Don't! No!
You ladies must leave now!
You ladies must go! (pointing off stage)

Florence: (moving in front of the Doctor)
S'cuse me, sir, really!
We're here now to work
And help all these wounded
To health, make them perk!

Soldiers Chorus: (All together, with enthusiasm and much waving of casts and bandages)
Yay, Yay, she's got the stuff!
Yay, Yay, Florence is tough!

Doctor Disapproval: (stepping to the side of Florence, gesturing to her)

Well, who would have "thunk" it? These ladies have made Such radical changes— Many lives have been saved!
