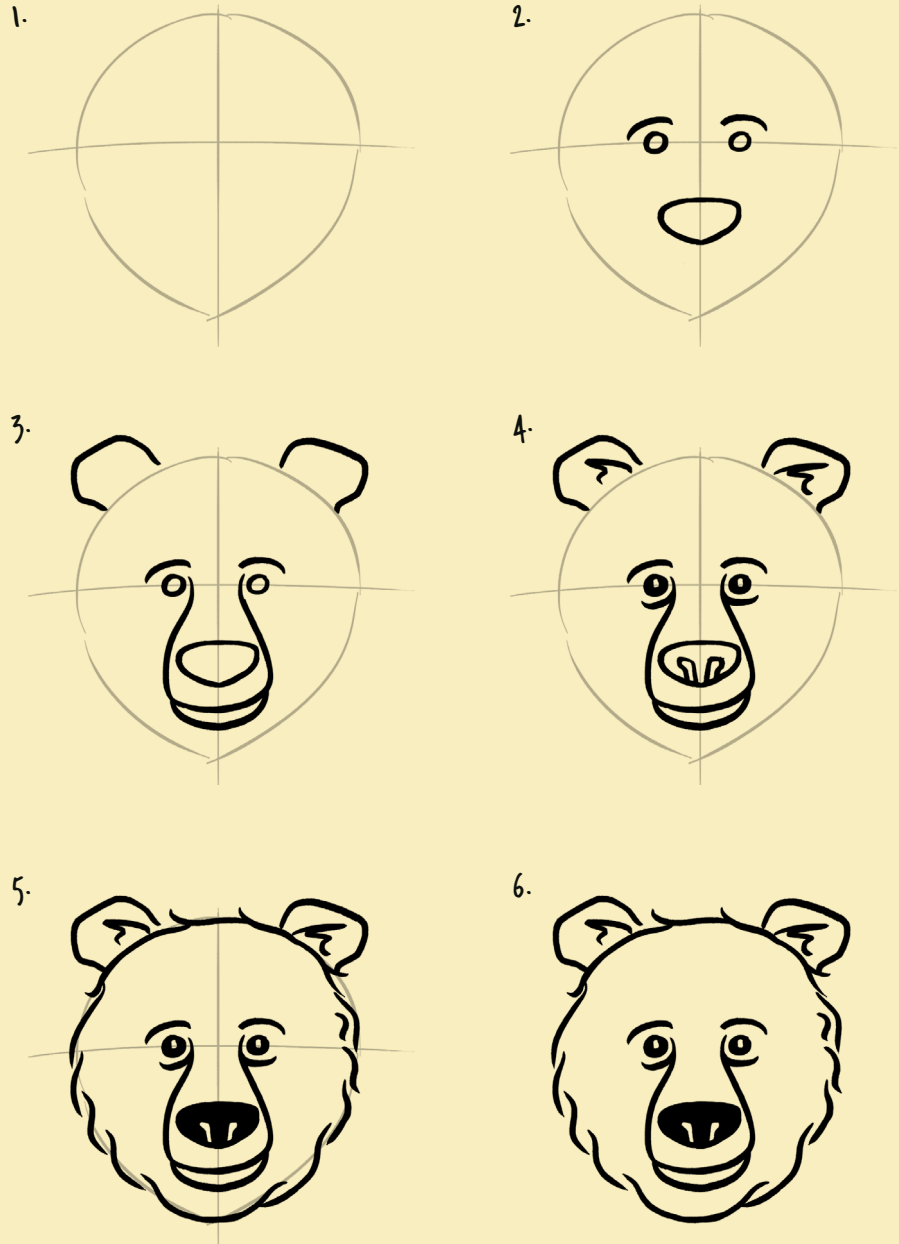


GRAB A PENCIL AND A PIECE
OF PAPER, AND LET'S DRAW!

1. Start by lightly sketching a balloon shape and some guidelines for the head. It's okay to be sloppy. It's always easier to have some reference lines.
2. Using more pressure, draw rough shapes of the eyes, eyebrows, and nose. Use the reference lines to keep things centered.
3. Time to add some big U shapes for the snout, mouth, and ears.
4. Now you can add some details to fill in the ears, eyes, and the shape of the nostrils.
5. Next fill in the nose and add his big furry head. This can be as simple or complex as you want. Throw in some nice squiggles.
6. Erase the reference lines, and you're done—unless you want to add some color. From here the rest is up to you!
