
GRAB A PENCIL AND A PIECE OF PAPER, AND LET'S DRAW!


- Start by lightly sketching a balloon shape and some guidelines for the head. It's okay to be sloppy. It's always easier to have some reference lines.
- Using more pressure, draw rough shapes of the eyes, eyebrows, and nose. Use the reference lines to keep things centered.
- 3. Time to add some big *U* shapes for the snout, mouth, and ears.
- Now you can add some details to fill in the ears, eyes, and the shape of the nostrils.
- Next fill in the nose and add his big furry head. This can be as simple or complex as you want. Throw in some nice squiggles.
- 6. Erase the reference lines, and you're done—unless you want to add some color. From here the rest is up to you!


