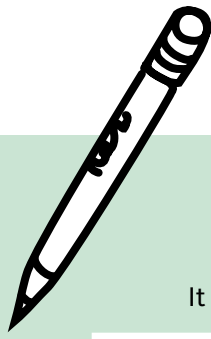


# GONE CAMPING
