Some people believe that the earth is millions of years old, but the Bible teaches that the earth is just a few thousand years old. Did you know that we can calculate the age of the earth using the genealogies (jee-nee-AH-luh-jees) in Genesis? A genealogy is a list of ancestors in a family such as parents, grandparents, and great-grandparents.

The genealogies in Genesis 5 and 11 tell us how old each father was when his son was born. We can add up their ages to find how much time passed between Adam and Abraham.




