BEST CHOICE AND VALUE: The 3-Day Bouncer Pass Plus Additional 3-Day Bouncer Parking Pass

Visit both the Creation Museum and Ark Encounter for three days within a one-week time frame.

BEFORE YOU ARRIVE

Purchase tickets and parking pass online for a smoother experience. Many programs are included in your admission, but check the hours and daily schedule for each attraction on their websites (CreationMuseum.org» and ArkEncounter.com») to determine if you require reservations for additional ticketed programs to avoid disappointment. We recommend you reserve a time for your ticketed zip line tour ahead of time. You can also get a discount voucher online for the Truth Traveler VR program located at the Ark Encounter.

Note that we recommend visiting the Creation Museum first as the Creation Museum's walk through history will lay the foundation for the rest of the rich teaching at both attractions!

DAY 1: CREATION MUSEUM

- Arrive early to rent strollers, wheelchairs, or ECVs and purchase any tickets you may need for special ticketed programs and the planetarium. The parking booths open ½ hour before the museum opens.
- Mid- to late morning is when the museum exhibits are busiest. Plan your day accordingly. The QR code below will take you to the museum's daily schedule.



- Enjoy any programs or talks being offered throughout the day, including our new 4D *Dragons: Quest for Truth* show that runs regularly and is included with admission. Consider coming back on your third day if you can't get to them all!
- Refresh yourself with a stroll around the beautiful botanical gardens and new Plants of the Bible Conservatory, visit the Creation Zoo, and see a live animal show. Children of all abilities can enjoy our playground.
- Don't miss the four special exhibits on the lower floor: *Buddy's Dino Den, Fearfully & Wonderfully Made, Borderland,* and *Dr. Crawley's Insectorium.* The *Radiance* identity exhibit will be opening in late 2025.
- Finish your day with some shopping at Dragon Hall Bookstore to take a piece of the Creation Museum and its teachings home with you. We also offer many fair-trade items! Grab a snack at Tree of Life Café on your way out and head to one of the off-site family-friendly dinner options listed below.

DAY 2: ARK ENCOUNTER

- Arrive early to rent strollers, ECVs, or wheelchairs and purchase any tickets you need for concerts, daily programs, shows, etc. The parking booths open ½ hour before the park opens.
- Save \$2 on the Truth Traveler VR experience when you purchase early access discount vouchers online» or at the admissions ticketing counters. This discount voucher must be redeemed for a showtime prior to 1 p.m. at the Truth Traveler building.
- Mid- to late morning is when the Ark's inside exhibits are busiest. Plan your day accordingly.
- Have lunch at Emzara's Buffet, Olive Leaf Café, or an outdoor venue while planning your afternoon. Our food venues offer options for any dietary needs».



- Enjoy any programs, concerts, or talks being offered throughout the day. Keep the schedule handy with the OR code below.
- Take a stroll through the beautiful grounds, Rainbow Gardens, Ararat Ridge Zoo, and Children's Zoo. Children of all abilities can enjoy our outdoor playground. Enjoy the carousel, bookstore, and fair-trade shopping.
- Grab a snack at Olive Leaf Café on your way out and see below for some other great dining options in the area.

DAY 3: YOU CHOOSE

- Now that you've been through both attractions, you know what you weren't able to see, so plan and experience them on your third day to go back through either or both attractions and experience them.
- With the Bouncer Pass, you can visit both attractions on any of the three days, but be aware that it takes about an hour to get from one attraction to the other.
