

HOW TO USE THIS CURRICULUM



This curriculum has been designed with multiple uses in mind. You will find a format suitable for individual study as well as a format for group study. This curriculum is also an excellent supplement to any Bible curriculum used in a Sunday school or homeschool setting, or can be used as a stand-alone curriculum that will surely lead to much discussion.

Suggested Order

Though not necessary, it is suggested that you view the videos in the following order:

1. Scripture Under Scrutiny
2. Why 66?
3. The Life of William Tyndale
4. The Authentic Christ

Individual Users

For maximum learning in an individual setting, it is recommended that you read over the complete viewing guide before viewing the video. As you watch the video, space is provided to record notes on the discussion, and you will need to fill in a few blanks with key words. After viewing the video and completing the viewing guide, complete the exercise questions as a way to check your understanding of what you have learned. Try to complete the exercise questions without referring to your notes from the viewing guide, and then check any answers you are unsure of against your notes.

Once you have completed the curriculum, don't keep the

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information to yourself. Share it with others in your family, church, youth group, or wherever you have the opportunity.

Group Users

When used in a group setting, it is strongly recommended that the leader complete the individual viewing guide before presenting the video to a group for discussion. It is also recommended that the leader review the group discussion questions and have prepared responses ready to guide the discussion. Identify specific Bible passages that can be referred to during the discussion, and encourage the participants to read and review the passages.

A group viewing guide is provided if you wish for those in your group to take notes while watching the DVD. You may copy these pages for your group members, or download printable letter-size PDFs for each video from www.answersingenesis.org/go/bible-is-true-dvds.

Group Discussion Questions

Some of the questions are intended to check for understanding, while others are directed at personal experience and application in daily life. We know that knowledge alone is not sufficient, but we must put that knowledge into action (Romans 2:13; James 1:22). Whenever possible, steer the discussion into a direction of application. Don't limit yourself to the questions provided, but take the discussion in a direction that meets the needs of your group. Allow individuals to provide input into the discussion, but be careful to check everything that is said against what is revealed in Scripture. You may consider closing the discussion with a call to action, "What are you going to do with what you have learned from this discussion?"
