

How to Use

Alphabet Apologetics Word Wall Cards help teach students the alphabet while introducing them to biblical vocabulary and apologetics. As you introduce each of the letters and its corresponding word, read the scriptural passage and accompanying teaching. Then hang the cards in your instructional area for student reference. When students learn an important vocabulary word, sight word, etc., position a card with the word on it underneath the Word Wall Card with the same letter as the first letter of the vocabulary or sight word. This will create a visual reminder of

all the important words students have learned.

A is for Adam



God created Adam (the first man) and Eve (the first woman) on day 6 of creation. He made man in his image, different from animals.

"So God created man in his own image, in the image of God he created him; male and female he created them." Genesis 1:27


B is for Bible

"All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness." 2 Timothy 3:16


C is for Cross
