We're all unique with our very own flair.

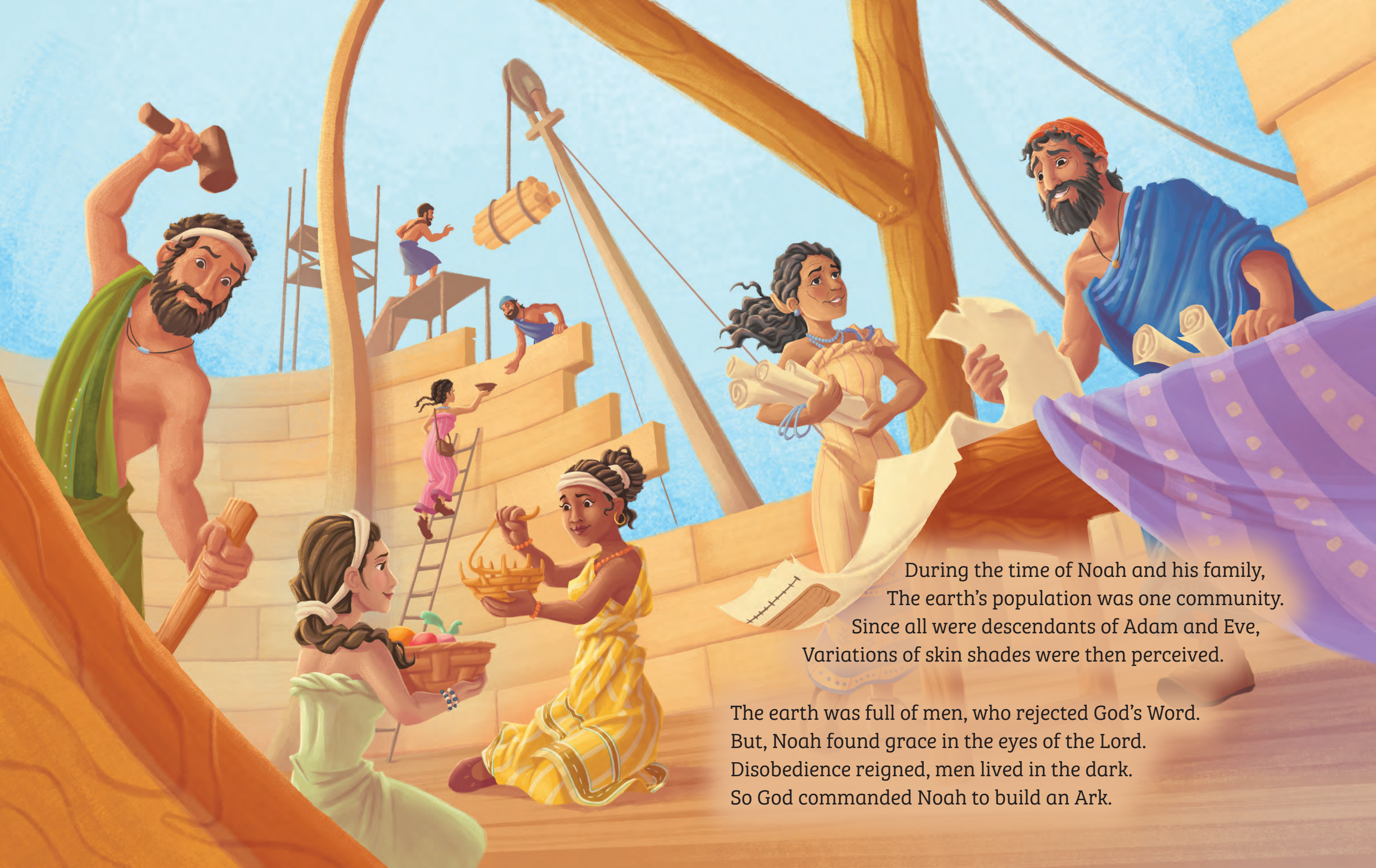


God made a pigment called melanin.
