## "What is the Big Bang?" Summary

The Big Bang Theory is the prevailing idea to explain the origin of the universe. Only naturalistic ideas for the existence of the universe are accepted, all others are labeled as being myth.

The current popular version of the Big Bang states that about 13.8 billion years ago there was a sudden appearance of all matter, energy, space, and time. They believe that the universe expanded and is continuing to expand outward like the surface of a balloon. For that reason, Big Bang theorists contend that there is no center to the universe. Our three dimensions exist on the surface of that "balloon."

Although many Christians want to believe the Big Bang may be the way that God created, the theory was originally designed to show how a universe could exist without divine intervention. However, this model fails to explain where the matter and energy came from in the first place.

It's also interesting to note that the Big Bang Theory has gone under some radical changes over the years, yet at every point of its revision, it has been claimed to be true. However, if they've been wrong about the details in the past, could the current version also be flawed? Can an ever-changing theory ever be presented as truth?

The secular idea that nothing became everything leaves the universe without purpose. But the Bible also speaks of a time when everything was spoken into existence from nothing, but it was the result of God bringing creation into being with ultimate purpose.
