

"The Wonderful Moon" Activity

A fun family activity would be to view the Moon at the first quarter phase like Dr. Lisle suggested.

- 1. Consult the lunar calendar to find out when the Moon is at its first quarter phase.
- 2. Either use a telescope or binoculars.
- 3. Find a nice vantage point to view the Moon (sometimes a drive makes it more special).
- 4. Look at the Moon and map out it's features.
- 5. Discuss what you see.
- 6. Give thanks to God for the Moon.
