

Chapter 1 – Why All the Interest in Aliens?

"Why All the Interest in Aliens?" Summary

In the last 80 years it seems our society has become obsessed with the search for aliens. From radio's "The War of the Worlds," to TV's, "Star Trek, "Lost in Space" and movies like, "Star Wars," the media has greatly influenced this idea. Add to that UFO sightings and reports of alien abductions, many have become convinced that aliens exist in some form or another. They believe it's just a matter of finding out where they are at in the universe. According to Dr. Lisle, we encounter aliens in some way or another every day, whether on TV, in science, or with NASA searching for life on Mars. Why is there such a fascination with aliens?



Dr. Faulkner discussed the fact that many people are curious to know whether or not we are alone in the universe. Finding other beings would be a huge event

that would make every other discovery insignificant. He compared battling aliens to the war that occurred in 1519 when Cortez overthrew the Aztec empire and burned Mexico in 1519 with only 120 men and a few canons against 100,000 soldiers. To the Aztecs, the Spaniards were an alien civilization.

Are we just bored? According to Dr. De Young, it's fun to think about animals and organisms completely different than anything we've seen before but it's also very evolutionary in its philosophy, which is the driving force for our current research.

But what does the creationist do with all this information? According to Dr. De Young this search for life needs to be addressed by creationists.
